TEN LACC STAFF OFF TO NIGERIA FOR TRAINING



Tuesday, November 12, 2019: The Liberia Anti-Corruption Commission (LACC) is to benefit from a two weeks capacity building and mentorship program for ten staff at the Commission.

The capacity building training was made possible from a request made by President George M. Weah to his Nigerian counterpart, President Muhammadu Buhari.

The program is sponsored by the Economic and Financial Crimes Commission (EFCC) of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as a result of a bilateral partnership program between the two countries.

The support is in line with Article 18, subsection 3 & 4 of the African Union Convention on Preventing and Combating Corruption (AUCPCC), which encourages State Parties to exchange expertise and provide assistance in preventing and combating corruption and related offenses.

The objective of this program is to enhance the investigative capacity of LACC authorities and provide a platform for the observation of judicial proceedings related to anti-corruption cases.

It will also afford the opportunity to highlight the effectiveness of inter-agency collaboration in the fight against corruption.
