

AN ACT OF THE NATIONAL LEGISLATURE TO AMEND CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE CHAPTER 15 OF THE TITLE 2 OF THE CODE OF LAW REVISED, ALSO KNOWN AS THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE LAW, TO PROVIDE FOR THE REMOVAL OF STATUTE OF LIMITATION ON CORRUPTION AND FINANCIAL CRIMES RELATED OFFENSES.

It is enacted by the national legislature of the republic of Liberia in Legislature assembled:

Effective date of Amendment:

That effective immediately after the passage and publication into hand bill of this act, Section 4.3 of the Criminal procedure law of Liberia is hereby amended and revised to read as follows:

Prosecution of an offense, a material element of which is either fraud or breach of fiduciary obligation, may be commenced at any time, even though the period provided for in section 4.2 above has expired.

This act shall take effect immediately upon publication in handbills.
